INTERNATIONAL STUD BOOK COMMITTEE CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION TO THE JOCKEY CLUB OF KENYA STUD BOOK

(Also Subject to the Rules of The Jockey Club Of Kenya 148 – 165.7 2018)

1. Definition

A Thoroughbred is a horse which is recorded in a Thoroughbred Stud Book Approved by the International Stud Book Committee at the time of its official recording.

The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book records the births of Thoroughbred progeny born in Kenya subject to these overall Conditions of Entry.

2. Pedigree

Any horse claiming admission to The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book, must be able either:-

2.1 to be traced down all lines of its pedigree to horses registered in The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book;

or

2.2 to be traced down all lines of its pedigree to horses registered in an Approved Stud Book of another country;

or

2.3 to prove satisfactorily eight recorded crosses consecutively with horses qualified as in categories 2.1 and 2.2 above, including the cross of which it is the progeny and to show such performance in races open to Thoroughbreds in all sections of its pedigree as to warrant its assimilation with "Thoroughbreds".

3. Ownership

The name and address of the owner of every Mare and Stallion must be lodged with The Jockey Club Of Kenya. The ownership recorded in The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book does not amount to legal registration of ownership of the animal and must not be construed as such.

4. Identification of Breeding Stock

4.1 Before any Stallion or Mare can be admitted to the Stud Book of Kenya, The Jockey Club Of Kenya must establish the horse's identity.

4.2 The identity of such Mare or Stallion is established by one or more of the following:

4.2.1 The completion by the Mare or Stallion's owner of the appropriate registration form.

4.2.2 Tracing the animal through all its ownerships since birth, in particular, by reference to the properly registered change of Ownership forms submitted to The Jockey Club Of Kenya.

4.2.3 In the case of imported horses, an Export Certificate identifying the animal must be received from the Stud book Authority of the Country from which the horse was exported. The Export Certificate must be accompanied by a document showing the horse's genotype issued by Laboratory which is an institutional Rank One member of ISAG.

4.2.4 Confirmation that the genotype of the Stallion or Mare agrees with the genotype held on record by The Jockey Club Of Kenya.

4.3 No animal may be registered for stud purposes retrospectively, after it has died, except at the discretion of The Jockey Club Of Kenya, and only if the animal's genetic type has been established prior to the animal's death.

4.4 The produce of any Mare or Stallion will not be admitted to The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book unless the genetic type of the Mare and Stallion has been established. The produce of any Mare or Stallion will not be admitted to The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book if the markings do not correspond with the DNA type and markings held on record by The Jockey Club Of Kenya.

5. Definition of a Breeder

The breeder of a horse is the person who owns the dam of such horse at the time the horse is born, and the names of breeders of any horses entered in the Stud Book shall be registered accordingly. The Jockey Club Of Kenya reserves the right to amend such records in light of subsequent information received.

6. Current Returns

In addition to the conditions set out in 9 and 13 below, the produce of any Mare will not be admitted to the Stud Book until the following documents have been received from the Breeder:

6.1 An official Certificate of Covering, signed confirming by the Stallion Owner or their authorised representative: the identity of the mare was confirmed before covering, the covering was by natural service (9.1.1) and must include the last date of service in the previous year or an electronic equivalent authorised by The Jockey Club Of Kenya.

6.2 An official Stud Book Return (Stud Book Return – Part One) signed by the Breeder or an electronic equivalent authorised by The Jockey Club Of Kenya giving details of the produce, namely the colour, sex and date of birth. Twins must be indicated. In the event of NO LIVE PRODUCE the official Return must still be completed indicating whether the Mare was Barren, Aborted early, or Slipped, or that produce was born dead or has died since birth. Failure to report this information will result in the term "No Return" appearing on the Mare's produce line. This detracts from the completeness, and thus the value, of the information in Stud Book publications.

- 6.3** A Foal Identification Certificate and Naming Form completed and signed by the Breeder or an electronic equivalent authorised by The Jockey Club Of Kenya for each live foal specified on the Part One for that Breeder, stating the parentage, colour, sex and date of birth of the produce and showing a written and graphic description of the markings of the produce. The Foal Identification Certificate must be approved as accurate by a representative of the Jockey Club of Kenya Stud Book Committee before a DNA test can take place as a required part of the initial registration process. Microchipping of foals/horses is not mandatory for horses which continually reside in Kenya.
- 6.4** Names applied for (in compliance with ISBC Rules and JCK Rule 163) with the Foal Identification Certificate and approved will be registered free of charge. A later naming application or change of registered name will be subject to the prescribed fee.
- 6.5 Payment of the prescribed Registration Fees**
The above requirements apply to produce which are registered in the year immediately following their year of foaling.
- 7. Late Returns**
For produce whose registration is not sought or completed until after the last acceptance date of registration, in addition to the above requirements for current returns, the following will apply:
- 7.1** The fee at the then current rate for late registrations must be paid, together with any penalty which may be imposed.
- 7.2** A certificate from a veterinarian certifying the age of the horse for which registration is sought.
- 8. Incomplete Returns**
- 8.1** Returns which are incorrect or incomplete, or which lack any of the required supporting documentation, will not be accepted and will be returned to the Breeder for completion.
- 8.2** The rate of fee payable for registering produce will be the rate in force on the date when the completed return is received. In the event that the corrected or completed return is sent back to The Jockey Club Of Kenya after the last acceptance date of registration, a penalty may be imposed.
- 9. Service To Produce An Eligible Foal**
- 9.1** A Foal is not eligible to be registered in the Stud Book unless:
- 9.1.1** It is the produce of a natural service or covering which is the physical mounting of a Mare by a Stallion with intromission of the penis and ejaculation of semen into the reproductive tract of the Mare being bred. This natural service may include the immediate reinforcement of a portion of the ejaculate produced by the Stallion during such mating, in the reproductive tract of the Mare being bred.
- and
- 9.1.2** Natural gestation took place in, and delivery was from, the body of the Mare in which the Foal was conceived.
- 9.2** Any foal conceived by artificial insemination, Embryo Transfer or Transplant, Cloning, or any other form of genetic manipulation shall not be registered in The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book.
- 10. Passports**
- 10.1** A passport is issued in respect of each horse registered as produce in The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book.
- 10.2** The passport shows descriptive particulars registered in respect of the animal, and are issued as an aid to the identification of the animal to which they refer and for its vaccination record to be maintained. They are not a certificate of ownership. While the information contained is believed to be correct, its accuracy cannot be guaranteed, in particular where this is dependent on information supplied to The Jockey Club Of Kenya.
- 11. Broodmare and Stallion Passports**
- 11.1** Passports that are issued when horses are first registered in the Stud Book must be retained and used for every Mare and Stallion that is registered for breeding purposes. The Passport shows the descriptive particulars registered in respect of the animal, and records its reported ownership. It is not a certificate of ownership.
- A Passport is issued as an aid to the identification of the animal to which it refers, though while the information contained is believed to be correct, its accuracy cannot be guaranteed, particularly where this is dependent on information supplied.
- 11.2** It is the responsibility of every Mare Owner to ensure that they are in possession of this Document of Identity so that it can be presented to the Stud Manager prior to the covering or foaling of the Mare.
- 11.3** Broodmare and Stallion Passports are the property of The Jockey Club Of Kenya and must be returned on demand. The passport should accompany the horse at all times unless required for administrative purposes.

- 12. Covering Records**
- 12.1** Stallion Owners are required to submit a list of all Mares covered by each particular stallion by no later than 31st January in the season of covering.
- 12.2** Books of Covering Certificates are issued for each Stallion when it is registered for breeding each season. Stallion Owners are required:
- 12.2.1** to enter on the Certificates and counterfoils the details of every mare covered by their Stallion in the season and sign as a true record. In particular, if a mare is covered by more than one Stallion, a separate entry must be made for each Stallion.
- 12.2.2** to issue a Covering Certificate to the Owner of each Mare covered by their Stallion.
- 12.2.3** to return the completed counterfoils to the Stud Book Department at the end of the covering season. It is a condition of the issue of Covering Certificates that the counterfoils will be returned not later than 31st January in the season of covering. No Covering Certificates can be issued for a Stallion for whom counterfoils are outstanding from the previous year or for a Stallion who has not been registered for the current covering season.
- 12.3** Prompt return of the counterfoils is essential to the Stud Book record system, and for the early and complete analysis of the season's covering activities.
- 13. Genetic Typing**
- 13.1** No horse will be registered in the Stud Book unless its parentage has been confirmed by DNA typing.
- 13.2** From January each year The Jockey Club Of Kenya will send persons to each Breeding Establishment which reports a live foal. All newborn foals must be presented so that blood can be drawn for DNA typing purposes. Failure to present any foal for blood collection may result in the foal not being eligible to be registered.
- 13.3** In the event that the parentage verification tests show that the foal was not from either or both of the parents as reported to The Jockey Club Of Kenya, The Jockey Club Of Kenya may request further blood samples from the foal, the mare and the stallion.
- 13.4** In the event that the correct parentage cannot be established through DNA testing, the responsibility to seek further information which may assist in determining the parentage of the foal remains with the breeder. At no time will it become the responsibility of The Jockey Club Of Kenya to determine the correct parentage of any foal.
- 14. Amendments to The Stud Book**
The Jockey Club of Kenya may make any alterations or amendments to the records contained in the Stud Book provided that such alterations or amendments will improve the accuracy of the Stud Book.
- 15. Disqualification / Removal from the General Stud Book**
Modification of the heritable genome of a prospective or registered Thoroughbred, during its conception, gestation or at any stage thereafter in its existence, will result in the horse forfeiting its status as a Thoroughbred (IABRW Article 12B) and its registration.
- 16. Complaints or Appeals**
Any complaints or Appeals are subject to the The Jockey Club Of Kenya should be forwarded in writing to the Senior Steward of Racing, copied to the Chairman of The Jockey Club Of Kenya Stud Book Committee.
- 17. Rules for Registering Names of Horses.**
Rules for the naming of foals, yearling and changes of names are included in JCK Rule 163

JOCKEY CLUB OF KENYA STUD BOOK RULES - PART XXIX

148. Definitions and Eligibility

148.1 A Thoroughbred is a horse, which is recorded in a recognized Thoroughbred Stud Book approved by the International Stud Book Committee at the time of its official recording.

148.2 Approved Stud Books are Stud Books of those countries approved by the International Stud Book Committee and shall be deemed to be Approved Stud Books.

148.3 The Jockey Club of Kenya Stud Book is the authority, which records the births of all Thoroughbred progeny foaled in Kenya or imported into Kenya and subject to these overall Conditions of Entry.

148.4 The Breeder of a horse is the person(s) or syndicate in whose name(s) and address(es) the dam of such horse is registered at the time the progeny is born and the names of breeders of any horses entered in the Stud Book shall be registered accordingly. The Jockey Club of Kenya reserves the right to amend such records in light of subsequent information received.

148.5 The Owner is the person(s) or syndicate whose name(s) and address(es) of every stallion or a mare to be recorded in the Jockey Club of Kenya Stud Book is registered with the Jockey Club of Kenya. Every application for registration shall be made to the Registry Office of the Jockey Club prior to 1st October in each year. The ownership recorded in the Jockey Club of Kenya Stud Book does not amount to legal registration of ownership of the animal and must not be construed as such.

148.6 Eligibility to be entered in the Jockey Club of Kenya Stud Book:

148.6.1 Pedigree Horses claiming admission to the Stud Book must:

148.6.1.1 Be the product of a mating between a sire and dam, both of which were registered prior to 1st January 1980 in a Stud Book approved by the International Stud Book Committee, or must trace in all lines of its pedigree to horses so registered, or

148.6.1.2 Be able to prove satisfactorily eight recorded crosses consecutively with horses in the category described in Rule 148.2.1, including the cross of which it is the progeny. Notwithstanding that a horse may qualify in terms of Rule 148.2.1, the Stewards of Racing reserve the sole right to refuse to record the horse in the Stud Book if it cannot prove satisfactorily eight recorded crosses consecutively, including the cross of which it is the progeny, with horses referred to in Rule 148.2.1.

148.6.2 No foal is eligible to be recorded in the Stud Book or the Non-Thoroughbred Register unless it is entirely the product of a natural service or covering which is the physical mounting of a mare by a stallion, followed by a natural gestation resulting in the delivery from the body of the mare in which the foal was conceived. The natural service can include the immediate re-enforcement of the stallion's service or cover by using any residual semen ejaculated by the stallion whilst it penetrated that mare during that service or that cover of that mare. No semen obtained from the stallion by any artificial means, may be used to re-enforce a service or covering. Where possible, the proposed use of the immediate re-enforcement of the stallion's service should be notified in advance to the Registry Office. Where this is not possible, such advice must be given within 24 hours after the re-enforcement. In either case, the names of the stallion, the mare, the person who will or who has supervised the re-enforcement and the relevant date shall be supplied;

148.6.3 No foal conceived by artificial insemination, embryo transfer or transplant, cloning or any other form of Genetic manipulation shall be eligible for registration or entry in the Stud Book or the Non-Thoroughbred Register. If modification of the heritable genome of a prospective Thoroughbred prior to or during its conception, gestation or at any stage thereafter in its existence will result in that horse forfeiting its status as a Thoroughbred and being deleted from the Stud Book [IABRW Article 12B];

148.6.4 In addition to the documentary evidence of a foal's parentage which the Stewards of Racing require, they may require further evidence by the use of parentage testing based on DNA Testing. Such DNA typing shall be undertaken by a laboratory appointed by the Stewards of Racing. Such Laboratory must be an institutional member of the ISAG and must be of Rank one (1). ALL DNA type details shall be confidential to the Stewards of Racing and shall not be divulged except to another Approved Stud Book Authority.

148.7 Notwithstanding that a horse is eligible for entry under rule 148.6, it shall not be entered in the Stud Book:

148.7.1 Until in the case of a horse being the progeny of an unnamed dam, the dam is named and the name is registered;

148.7.2 Until the identity and breeding of the horse is established to the satisfaction of the Stewards of Racing.

For Horses Bred in Kenya:

148.7.3 Unless the stallion owner, the stallion, the mare owner and the mare were registered by the Jockey Club when the mare was covered or before 1st October of each breeding year.

148.7.4 Unless the mare owner and the mare were registered with the Jockey Club when the foal was born;

148.7.5 Unless the application for registration is accompanied by a Certificate of Covering (R-1b) in the form prescribed by the Stewards of Racing signed by the owner of the sire or by his authorized agent, including confirmation that the mare was fully identified prior to serving according to her passport details;

148.7.6 Unless the application for registration is made in terms of these Rules, and

148.7.7 Unless the application for registration is received in the Registry Office of the Jockey Club on or before 15th February following the year in which the foal(s) was born except with the permission of the Stewards of Racing and on the payment of such penalty as they may impose.

For Imported Horses and Exported Horses:

148.8 No imported thoroughbred horse shall be registered in the Stud Book unless duly registered by an Approved Stud Book and as an imported horse in accordance with these Rules.

148.9 A Stud Book certificate and export pedigree in respect of any thoroughbred horse exported from Kenya shall not be issued until the age and markings of the horse have been taken by a qualified Veterinary Surgeon for inclusion in the certificate and the prescribed fees paid.

148.10 A horse exported from Kenya under these rules and re-imported will be considered to be an imported horse and subject to the provisions of Rule 156.

THE NON-THOROUGHBRED REGISTER

149. Eligibility to the Non-Thoroughbred Register

149.1 Any horse not eligible for inclusion in the Jockey Club of Kenya Stud Book but which is registered by the Jockey Club shall have its name and pedigree recorded in the Non-Thoroughbred Register.

149.2 No horse shall be registered in the Non-Thoroughbred Register unless the names of its sire and dam are registered in either the Stud Book or the Non-Thoroughbred Register.

149.3 No horse shall be registered in the Non-Thoroughbred Register unless the documentation similar to that required for the registration of a horse in the Stud Book is completed.

PROMOTION OF A HORSE FROM THE NON-THOROUGHBRED REGISTER TO THE STUD BOOK

150. A horse may be promoted from the Non-Thoroughbred Register to the Stud Book provided that:

150.1 The horse can prove eight thoroughbred crosses (defined as a mating in which either the sire or dam is one of the category of horses defined in Rules 148.2 or 148.3 consecutively, including the cross of which it is the progeny);

150.2 The horse can show such performances, in races open to thoroughbreds, in both the thoroughbred and non-thoroughbred sections of its pedigree as to warrant its assimilation with thoroughbreds, and

150.3 The Promotion is approved by the unanimous agreement of the International Stud Book Committee.

151. In abeyance.

Part XXX

REGISTRATION OF OWNERS OF HORSES AT STUD

152. Any person who owns a stallion or a mare at stud shall register as a stallion or mare owner, as the case may be. Every application for registration shall be made to the Registry Office of the Jockey Club prior to 1st October in each year.

153. Any registration shall be conditional upon payment of such fees and additional fees within 30 days of the registration being approved, failing which it shall lapse and be of no force and effect.

154. The Stewards of Racing may, in their sole discretion, grant, refuse to grant, renew or refuse to renew any registration of any stallion owner or mare owner.

155. Every registration as a stallion owner or as a mare owner shall expire on 30th September in each year.

156. Every registered stallion owner and every registered mare owner shall be bound by these Rules and by any decisions of the Stewards of Racing or the Stud Book Committee.

157. Every registered stallion owner shall:

157.1 Maintain a 'Register of Coverings', in a form acceptable to the Stewards of Racing. Such register must be available, at all reasonable times, for inspection by a representative of the Jockey Club;

157.2 Submit to the Registry Office of the Jockey Club all covering certificate stubs (R-1a) by not later than 15th February immediately following the covering season;

157.3 Advise the Registry Office of the Jockey Club, in writing, of the death of any stallion owned by him, by not later than 30 days following the death;

157.4 Advise the Registry Office of the Jockey Club, in writing, of the castration of any stallion owned by him within 30 days of the event;

157.5 Advise the Registry Office of the Jockey Club, on the prescribed form, of any change of ownership of a stallion owned by him, within 30 days of the event, and

157.6 Permit at all reasonable times, a representative of the Jockey Club to inspect and examine his stallions.

158. Every registered mare owner shall:

- 158.1 Maintain records of his breeding operations in a form acceptable to the Stewards of Racing;
- 158.2 Permit a representative of the Jockey Club to inspect and examine his stud records and any other documents concerning his horses and breeding operations, at all reasonable times;
- 158.3 Permit a representative of the Jockey Club to inspect and examine his mares and foals at all reasonable times;
- 158.4 Advise the Registry Office of the Jockey Club, in writing, of the death of any mare, yearling or foal under his care, not later than by the next Stud Book Return (SB-R) due the 15th February following the death. In the case of an unnamed or unregistered horse the date of birth, colour, sex and breeding of such horse must be stated;
- 158.5 Advise the Registry Office of the Jockey Club, in writing, of the de-sexing of any mare under his care within 30 days of the event;
- 158.6 Advise the Registry Office of the Jockey Club, on the prescribed form, of any change of ownership of any horse owned by him, within 30 days of the event;
- 158.7 Apply for the registration, in the Stud Book or the Non-Thoroughbred Register, of all foals bred by him during the foaling season by not later than 15th February immediately following the foaling season and submit to the Registry Office of the Jockey Club, the prescribed fees and the following documents, which documents shall be accurately completed in all respects:
- 158.8 The covering certificate tear-off portion (R-1b),
- 158.9 The foal identification certificate and naming form (R-2),
- 158.10 The Stud Book Return (SB-R).

REGISTRATION OF STALLIONS AND MARES

159. Registration of Stallions and Mares

159.1 Any person who owns a stallion or a mare at stud shall register all his stallions and mares at stud for the ensuing year and every application for registration is to be made to the Registry Office of the Jockey Club prior to 1st October in each year in respect of each stallion or mare at stud at that time. Where a later application is made for the registration of a stallion or mare, when the stallion has already served a mare or a mare has already been covered, then the Stewards of Racing may in their discretion accept or reject such late application and may in addition to the prescribed fee, impose an additional fee in an amount which shall be determined by the Stewards of Racing in respect of each stallion and/or mare, per case.

159.2 Any registration shall be conditional upon payment of such fees and additional fees within 30 days of the registration being approved, failing which it shall lapse and be of no force and object.

159.3 The Stewards of Racing may, in their sole discretion, grant, refuse to grant, renew or refuse to renew any registration of any stallion or mare. They may also temporarily suspend any registration of a stallion or mare.

Part XXI

REGISTRATION OF HORSES, INCLUDING FOALS

160. Registration of Horses and Foals

160.1 No person shall enter or start a horse for any race unless such horse and its name are registered in the Stud Book or Non-Thoroughbred Register. Save that in early closing races, horses may be entered under their sire, dam, colour, sex and date of birth. This proviso does not apply to starting in a race when all registrations of such horse must have been completed by final declaration for such a race.

160.2 A Kenya Bred or foaled progeny shall not be registered later than 15th February immediately following the foaling season in which it was born, save where the Stewards of Racing in exceptional circumstances, otherwise determine and subject further to the payment of such penalty as the Stewards of Racing may determine.

160.3 All persons who register Kenya bred or foaled progeny will be supplied with an identity document in the August according to coverings registered. Such document must be completed in all respects, including the vaccination history of the horse, and shall be returned to the Registry Office of the Jockey Club with the prescribed fee by such person by the latest, 15th February of the year following foaling. The Foal Identity Document must be filled in by the breeder or his agent and must include accurately: sex, colour, markings, whorls/ridges and distinct physical characteristics. A minimum of five characteristics should be shown. The document must be then countersigned as accurate by the Veterinary Surgeon or a Jockey Club representative before DNA testing may be performed on that foal.

160.4 In completing the required Yearling Identity Document for full registration of Kenya Bred Yearlings, the breeder or his agent must include accurately: sex, colour, markings and whorls/ridges. Distinct physical characteristics including those subsequently acquired since the initial foal registration must also be included. A minimum of five characteristics should be shown. A Yearling Identity Document must also be completed for horses imported and registered in Kenya when foals.

160.5 A horse foaled in Kenya or imported shall not be registered in the Stud Book or in the Non-Thoroughbred Register unless the registration has complied with the Rules and/or regulations covering entry into such books and complied with all other required provisions, and the Stewards of Racing in their discretion have approved such registration.

160.6 The Stewards of Racing have the right to suspend temporarily the registration of any partially registered foal or weanling or fully registered horse (yearling and older). This will take effect when in the opinion of an appointed Jockey Club Panel of a Veterinary Officer and two other persons authorized by the Stewards of Racing, such horses are not deemed to be in the fit condition expected for their age or status according to the Weight and Body Condition Scoring as published in Appendix E of the Stewards' Instructions. Removal of the suspension will require a further examination by a Jockey Club Panel prior to a decision by the Stewards of Racing to lift the suspension.

161. Registration of Imported Horses

161.1 No person shall import any Thoroughbred horse into Kenya for racing or registered breeding purposes in contravention of these Rules, any governmental veterinary requirements or any law and without subsequently applying to the Registry Office of the Jockey Club for the registration of such horse. The person responsible for the importation of a horse into Kenya shall notify the Registry Office of the Jockey Club within 30 days of such horse's arrival in Kenya.

161.2 An application of the registration of an imported horse shall be made to the Registry Office and shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee and the following documents:

161.2.1 The Stud Book certificate or other appropriate certificate issued by the Approved Stud Book authority of the country of foaling;

161.2.2 A certificate of age and identity signed by the Veterinary Surgeon who examined the horse after its arrival in Kenya;

161.2.3 The racing record of the horse (if it has reached racing age);

161.2.4 Document of Description (Passport) and any other documents required by the Stewards of Racing, and

161.3 Horses will before importation have been tested negative for Equine Viral Arteritis (E.V.A), have a current negative Coggins Test Certificate (for Equine Infectious Anaemia) and a current Equine Influenza Vaccination Certificate. Horses imported for breeding purposes only will, in addition, be required to have been tested negative for *Taylorella Equigenitalis* (Contagious Equine Metritis [C.E.M.]) within one month of the date of importation.

161.4 A named horse imported into Kenya shall have the suffix of its country of foaling added to its name.

161.5 An unnamed horse imported into Kenya shall be named after registration with the agreement of the Approved Stud Book of its foaling and the suffix of its country of birth included in its name.

162. Conditions of Registration for Racing or Breeding Purposes

No application for the registration of an imported horse shall be considered unless the provisions of all relevant Rules have been complied with.

163. Registration of Names of Horses

163.1 A name may be registered for a horse by application on the prescribed form, only by a breeder or owner (148.5) or his authorized agent with written documentation on the owner's behalf (148.5).

163.2 All names shall be subject to approval by the Registry Office and not less than two members of the Stud Book Committee, which shall not approve the registration of the following names:

163.2.1 Those consisting of more than 18 characters, including punctuation marks and/or spaces, save that 18 characters may be exceeded when a country code suffix is required;

163.2.2 Those on the ISBC International or National List of Protected Names;

163.2.3 Those which are already registered;

163.2.4 Those of a similar spelling or pronunciation to those already registered;

163.2.5 Those of well known living or exceptionally famous people, save where written permission is obtained from the person or the descendants of the person concerned, by the person seeking to register the name;

- 163.2.6 Those consisting entirely of initials and/or numbers or followed by initials and/or numbers;
- 163.2.7 Those in bad taste or which have an unacceptable connotation in any language;
- 163.2.8 Those of a company or product without the written permission of the managing director of the company concerned.
- 163.3 On payment of the prescribed fee, the name will be registered and published and will after registration, be the horse's name under the Rules.
- 163.4 If the same name be simultaneously claimed for two or more horses, the order of priority shall be determined by lot at the Registry Office.
- 163.5 A registered name agreed by the Jockey Club of Kenya or another approved Stud Book shall not be changed except with the permission of the Stewards of Racing and if that case with the approval of the original Approved Stud Book and then only on payment of the prescribed fee.
- 163.6 No change of a registered name shall be permitted once that name has been a published entry for any race, except in the case of an early closing race, unless that change of name is ordered by the Stewards of Racing.
- 163.7 The Stewards of Racing may, without notice to any person, without hearing any person and without giving any reason, order a registered name to be changed. If such change be so ordered, the horse shall not be qualified to be entered or start until the proper application for a change to a name, which has been submitted and approved (163.5).

164. Ages of Horses

- 164.1 The Kenyan racing year shall be from 1st August to 31st July of the following year. A registered horse, no matter where it was foaled, shall be aged in the following way:
- 164.1.1 If a foal is born between 1st July and 31st December, it will be deemed to be a yearling (i.e. one year old on 1st August of the following year provided that the dam of the foal was first covered on or after 1st September during the same year prior to its birth and provided a covering certificate shows the mare was not served prior to 1st September of the year prior to foaling);
- 164.1.2 If a foal is born between 1st January and 30th June, it will be deemed to be a yearling on 1st August of the same year.
- 164.2 Where any doubt or dispute to the age of a horse exists, the age of the horse shall be determined by a licensed Veterinary Surgeon.

PASSPORTS

165. Passports
- 165.1 Jockey Club of Kenya Passports for all Kenya Bred or foaled horses shall be issued by the Jockey Club in respect of all horses registered with it and any passport so issued shall remain the property of the Jockey Club.
- 165.2 The person responsible for the care of a horse registered with the Jockey Club shall ensure that he is in possession of its Passport.
- 165.3 The owner and/or person responsible for the care or training of a foal, or of a horse registered with the Jockey Club, shall comply with the instructions contained in a Passport as issued by the Jockey Club from time to time and shall ensure that all Passports are made available for inspection at a time and place requested by any Steward, licensed Official or any person authorized by the Stewards of Racing, or be subject to such penalty as they impose.
- 165.4 The owner and/or person responsible for the care or training of a foal, or a horse registered with the Jockey Club, shall be responsible for the completion and updating of a Passport and shall ensure that such passport contains an up-to-date record of all details required by the Stewards of Racing, including its vaccination history. This Rule also includes the necessity to have ownership and the change of ownership details provided and endorsed in the Passport.
- 165.5 No unauthorized person may change or amend any information contained in the Passport, which may affect the identification or vaccination record of that horse.
- 165.6 No horse shall be entered for a race unless the person responsible for the care or training of that horse is in possession of its Passport.

165.7 No horse shall be eligible to run in any race until it has been identified by a Steward or other authorized Official. Any horse which cannot be identified to the satisfaction of the Stewards before a race shall be withdrawn by a Stipendiary Steward or the Stewards of the meeting.
